IMPORTANT INFORMATION

DROP OFF / PICK UP INFO

Drop off time for Day Camp is 8:30am to 9:00am. **PLEASE DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD EARLIER THAN 8:30AM**, as we will not have the staff to look after your child nor take responsibility for unattended children. **UPON ARRIVAL EACH MORNING, PLEASE DROP OFF YOUR CHILD(REN) IN FRONT OF THE CHURCH (Drive-Thru style).**

PLEASE BE PUNCTUAL WHEN DROPPING OFF AND PICKING UP YOUR CHILD. Camp hours of operation are 9:00am to 5:00pm. We discourage late arrivals past 9:00am as this disrupts our schedule as well as creating stress upon our staff. Pick up time is between 5:00pm to 5:30pm. If you must pick up your child earlier than 5:00pm, please contact the Coordinator Emilie Lau at least a day in advance so that she can accommodate you. Otherwise, we encourage you to allow your child to participate until the end of each camp day. **LATE PICK UP FEES APPLY AFTER 5:45PM.**

CAMP T-SHIRTS

Your child will be given a camp t-shirt on the first day of camp. **PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR CHILD IS WEARING IT EACH DAY WE HAVE A FIELD TRIP** as this helps our staff to keep our campers from straying from our group. Since field trips are scheduled almost daily, you may have your child bring the t-shirt in and wear it only during the trip so to minimize frequent washing. However, **please print your child's name on the t-shirt label to avoid mix up.**

LUNCHES AND MEDICATIONS

Please **DO NOT** send peanut butter sandwiches, any snacks with peanuts, or any products containing peanut oil in your child's lunch due to our campers who have **severe peanut allergies**. Enjoy your peanut butter at home and not at Day Camp. Thank you for your cooperation. **DO NO BRING MICROWAVEABLE LUNCHES.** Please pack an extra drink in their lunch to ensure your child has enough drinks throughout the day. The camp will provide a light nutritious snack and drink each morning and afternoon.

If your child requires special medication, please have it **clearly labelled with your child's name and dosage instructions** and leave it with the staff at the registration table. Also, indicate to the staff the name of your child's teacher so that he/she can administer the medicine to your child.

CAMP ACTIVITIES

We strongly recommend you allow your child to fully participate in all camp activities. However, if you do not wish your child to participate in certain activities, please notify the Camp Coordinator **in writing, in advance.**

We do not recommend children to bring toys to camp as we will not be responsible for any loss or damage to personal belongings, except on special days. (i.e. Show and Tell) when children are encouraged to bring a personal belonging or toy for sharing. Please **DO NOT** bring any **electronics** to camp (i.e. game boys, tamagotchis, mp3s, ipods, etc.), or **pokemon cards and any related cards**. They will be **CONFISCATED** and returned after the camp session.

ITEMS TO BRING TO CAMP
